Dear Parents,

I hope you enjoyed the holiday break, are well rested, and ready to get back into the swing of things. January has been an extremely productive month. On January 5 a team of teachers, school district representatives and I attended an NCA workshop. At the workshop we began the task of preparing Oakland Elementary School and The School District of the City of Royal Oak for district accreditation. Traditionally each school in the district would work toward accreditation. Royal Oak will now seek district accreditation. This has little effect on Oakland Elementary School because the goals are aligned with the district goals.

Oakland is currently implementing strategies to meet these NCA goals in reading, writing, math, and school climate. Our last review of data indicated that Oakland Elementary School students have made significant gains in math. Our last review of climate data indicated that there was a 28% drop in discipline referrals. Please look for a parent perception survey which will be e-mailed to you in the beginning of February.

We are beginning the process of making preparations for next year. We are completing the building budget and reviewing student enrollment numbers. This information will be used to create the best learning environment possible for our students.

Last week we conducted our first lockdown drill in concert with the ROPD. The drill went off without a hitch and Officer Millard was very impressed with our drill. We will conduct one more drill in the coming months. We also held a charity event for Oakland Elementary School January 7-10 and raised over \$5400. Thank you to everyone who volunteered their time to help.

Hello, Oakland Parents! We hope this finds you well and back in the swing of things this school year. We wanted to take a moment to introduce ourselves and remind you what collecting Box Tops for Education can do for our students – at no cost to you!

We are Kirsten Buys and Sarah Patenaude, your Box Tops for Education coordinators at Oakland. What this means is just that we collect, count and submit the Box Tops you send in with your children every month, and then Box Tops cuts us a check a couple of times a year. Last year, that meant about \$1,000 that went toward various events the Oakland PTA hosted. More Box Tops = More \$ = More for The Roadrunners. The possibilities are endless when it comes to what Box Tops money can do.

If you're not aware, here's what Box Tops look like:

They are on tons of products – from granola bars and butter to toilet paper and diapers. For each one we submit, we get 10 cents. It's that simple. We hand them in, we get money back. Sometimes coupons for extra Box Tops will even come out with the coupons you get at Meijer too. There are contests on the Box Tops website for extra Box Tops (as many as 50,000 of them!) and you can earn Box Tops money for the school by shopping at various sites through the Box Tops website (for example, I believe I earned about \$1.50 by getting to BarnesAndNoble.com through the BT4E site last year – the cost of books was the same, but Oakland got a cut!).

Here is where you can learn about all the ways you can earn Box Tops, track the school's progress, download more fun collection worksheets like the one attached and even print off coupons to use at the store for everything from Gogurt and Cheerios to cleaning products, depending on the month. Here's the site: <http://www.boxtops4education.com>. Feel free to share the link too – grandparents, aunts and uncles can collect them too.

Send the Box Tops in with your child and we'll collect and count them every month. Students in classroom that collects the most each month will get some kind of prize or treat and the classroom that collects the most all year will get a big pizza party at the end of the year.

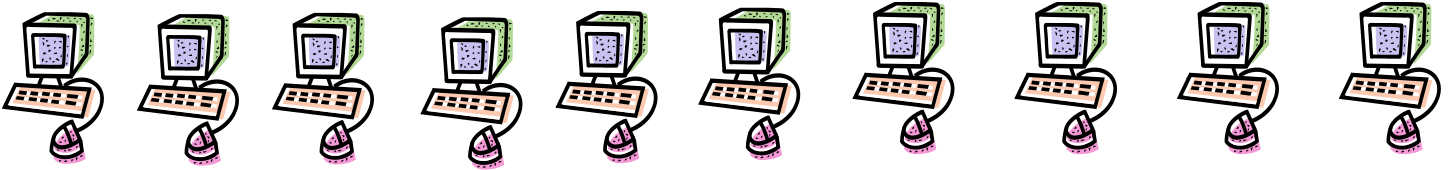

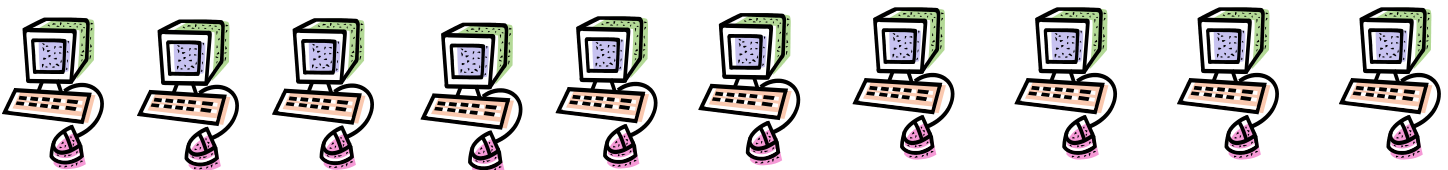


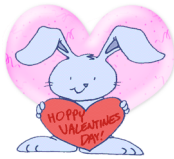
